CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 8:05 p.m. by Carrie Kulak. Carrie thanked everyone who participated in the musical novelties silent auction tonight.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

TREASURER'S REPORT

Jackie Chen reported that as of October 4, 2010, the checking account balance was \$31,881.08. The savings account balance is 24,878.80, which gives us a total balance of \$56,759.88. Credit statements are available for pickup tonight. Reports will be filed for audit.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

BAND DIRECTOR:

-  October 23rd is picture day. Picture envelopes will be given out one week in advance. Pictures begin at 10:00.
-  October 30th is Senior day and 8th graders from the middle schools were encouraged to come to the game and play in the stands with the band to fire them up for marching band in high school. Carrie asked if we could give them some of this year's band shirts if we have enough. Mrs. Giunta said the students were going to sign up so we could do this. It was agreed to do this.
-  Other recruitment ideas were to coordinate with SMU peer leader members to walk to Reynolds to recruit. Exam week may be a good week since it would not require teacher coverage. It was suggested from the floor that Mrs. Giunta include the parochial schools such as Faith Baptist, St. Greg's, OLS, etc. as well as the three middle schools in the recruitment process. She will also address the issue of middle school guidance counselors not allowing students to register for band if they were not involved in concert or jazz band their eighth grade year.
